COVID UPDATE

- As of 8/12/2020

66 Positive Cases for People Served; 2 deaths

13 People Residing with Family

Alameda and Contra Costa Counties

- Both still under Shelter in Place.
- Masks/Face Covering, Handwashing, Physical Distancing
- On the County Watch List Meaning that Changes in Shelter in Place won't occur until COVID 19 cases have declined to the point counties off the watch list for 14 days

Adults

- Most non-residential site based programs continue to be closed. Process for Re-entry is on pause due to county restrictions.
- Alternative Service Delivery Framework to Start in September
- Remote Service Delivery Continues

Attendance at Day Services

- Directive Issued to Limit attendance at out of home programs for those residing in ARFPHSNs and ICF DDN and CNs

- Support when parent working or in educational pursuit, Both minors and adults
