Name of Agency:

RCEB FY 23-24 #4: EDEA Care Integrity Transportation Services, LLC - A California Limited Liability Company formed in May 2024.

Summary:

In late 2023, respondents to RCEB Community Resource Development Plan (CRDP) Needs Survey FY 23-24 identified the need for specialized transportation. On December 19, 2024, RCEB submitted the Community Resource Development Plan and Community Placement Plan proposal. On January 18, 2024, Department of Developmental Services approved funding for \$250,000 for specialized transportation for RCEB clients with changing mobility and vision needs, and who require shorter route times. Through the RFP process, EDEA Care Integrity Transportation Services LLC was selected to provide this service.

Contract Overview:

The attached Start Up Agreement, dated June 1, 2024, represents Community Resource Development Plan (CRDP) funding for \$250,000 for development of a specialized transportation service for RCEB clients who have changing vision or mobility needs and whom require transportation to and from home and their day program with shorter route times of under one hour and a half. The start up funding will include training for the drivers to meet the changing mobility and/ or vision needs of RCEB clients.

EDEA Care Integrity Transportation Services, LLC has been awarded the project to provide a Specialized Transportation Service for clients from RCEB with changing mobility and vision needs and will provide 3 to 4 vehicles that can seat up to 16 adult passengers.

Location of the Service:

EDEA Care Integrity Transportation Service LLC will provide transportation services in Alameda and/or Contra Costa County.

History of Company's Operation:

EDEA Care Integrity Transportation Services, LLC - A California Limited Liability Company was formed in May 2024.

Dennis Ramas, who will serve as the Executive Director, is an RN and has extensive medical

experience working in hospitals/ER rooms, trauma centers, nursing/convalescent homes and acute care facilities since 2000. He has also experience with the Intellectual and Developmentally Disabled community working at Specialized Residential Facilities and Behavioral Day Programs since 2016.

Dennis Ramas is vendored through North Bay Regional Center to provide specialized residential services to 4 adults. The home is Sakura Home in Fairfield and has been in operation since 2022. He is also the licensee to a behavior management day program-Beacon Day Program in Fairfield, which has been in operation since 2020. There are no know quality assurance issues as reported by North Bay Regional Center.
