SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- 1. Receives referrals of families within RCEB with a need for additional support to complete processes including transition assessments and routine meetings to maintain RCEB services.
- 2. Provides outreach by phone and in person to referred families. Identifies potential barriers and works with supervisor to reduce these in order to complete processes.
- 3. Supports families in the completion of required RCEB documentation.
- 4. Explains the types of services available through the regional center to families.
- 5. Reviews cases that have been closed previously and makes contact to identify if there is a current need for services.
- 6. Works with interpreters to provide support to those who speak languages other than English and Spanish.
- 7. Participates in community outreach and education activities targeted to underserved communities.
- 8. Links families with other resources as needed. Maintains relationships with community partners.
- 9. Assists in gathering statistics.
- 10. Completes required reports, recording and forms.
- 11. Completes special agency assignments when requested.
- 12. May assist in conducting orientation sessions and support groups to new consumers/families.
