Name of Agency: Unified Compassionate Solutions, Inc., a California corporation formed in 2008.

Summary:

Unified Compassionate Solutions has applied to become a Supported Living Services (SLS) service provider. The agency is prepared to serve up to 10 individuals, initially, who have intellectual or physical disabilities. The agency is focused on providing support to individuals with forensic background and support needs that include behavioral challenges, judiciary involvement, and substance abuse.

Unified Compassionate Solutions, Inc. is prepared to serve individuals in both Alameda County and Contra Costa County.

Contract Overview:

The attached Service Provider Agreements represents Purchase of Service (POS) funding for one SLS agency serving up to 10 adult individuals who are clients of RCEB.

History of Company's Operation:

Gregory Holler will serve as the Executive Director of the agency. Mr. Holler has a Ph.D in Psychology and Master's Degree in Counseling Psychology. He has served as behavior consultant to SLS agencies and for behavioral support agencies including RCEB funded Omelagah, Inc. and Understanding Behavior agency. He has sat on the board of directors for Unified Compassionate Solutions, which has operated in the GGRC area, and also served as the clinical director and community based forensic adaptive skills trainer for the agency.

Krystovia Marquez will serve as the Program Director of the agency. Ms. Marquez has an extensive professional background in mental health services having worked as a clinical case manager for several behavioral health agencies as well as in the psychiatric department at Fremont Hospital. She also has experience providing behavioral intervention services for individuals with Autism and other developmental disabilities while working for Autism Comprehension Services (ACES). She also served as lead house staff at Divine Supportive Professionals care home from 2011 – 2012.

Glenda Presley will serve as Program Supervisor of the agency. She has been acting as the Program Director for Unified Compassionate Solutions in the GGRC area since 2007. She was regional director for STA NorCal Oakland/Walnut Creek/Hayward from 1987-2007 and worked for the ARC in Alameda County prior to that going back into the late 1970's.

Zachary Wheeler is the owner of the company which was founded back in 2008.
