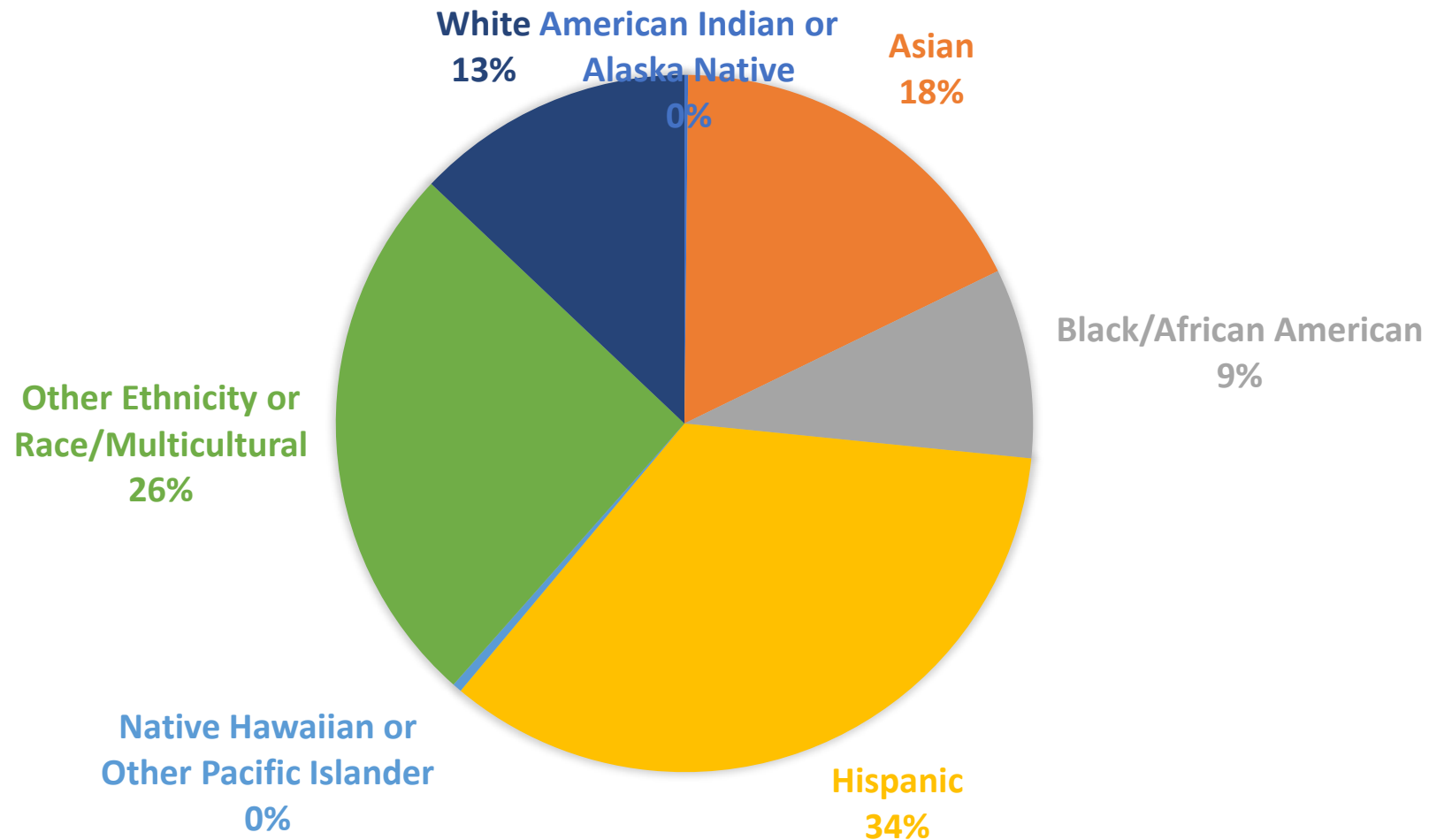

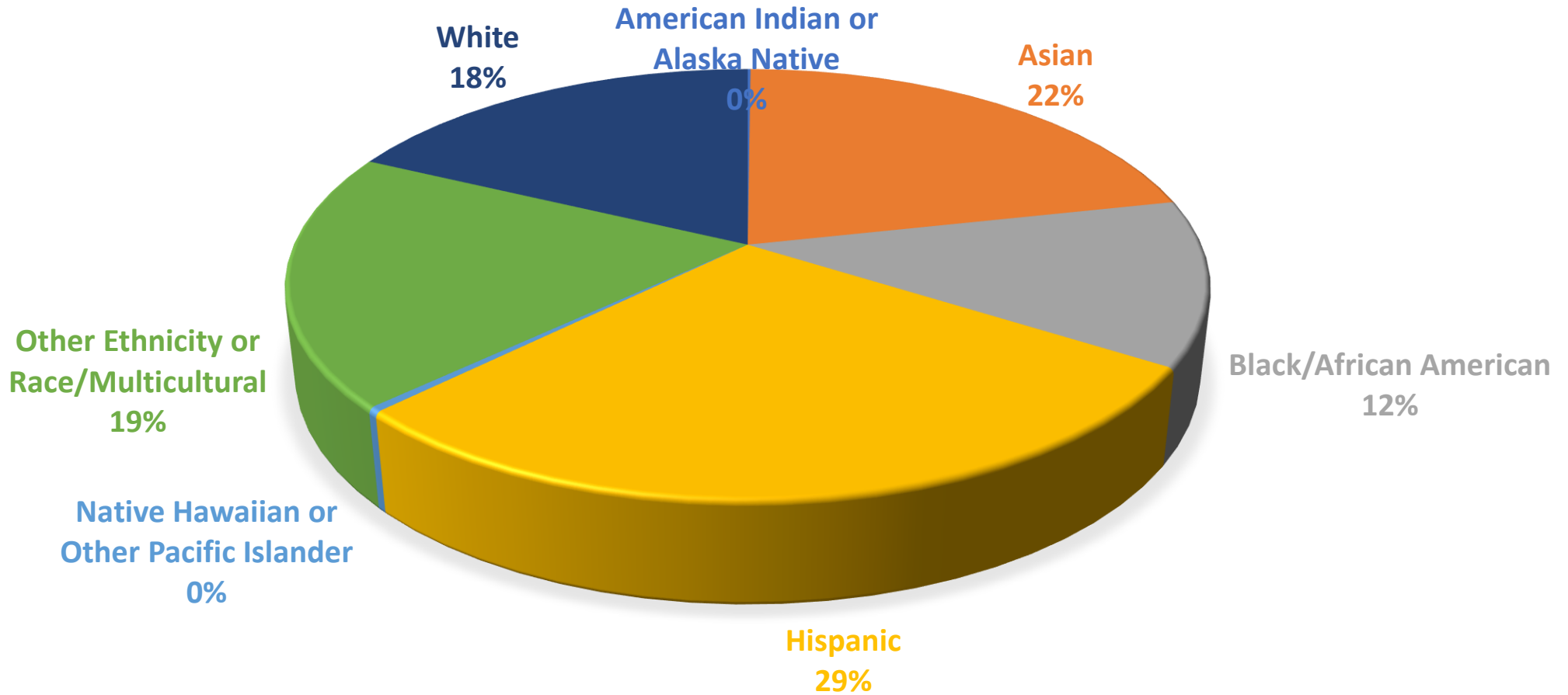

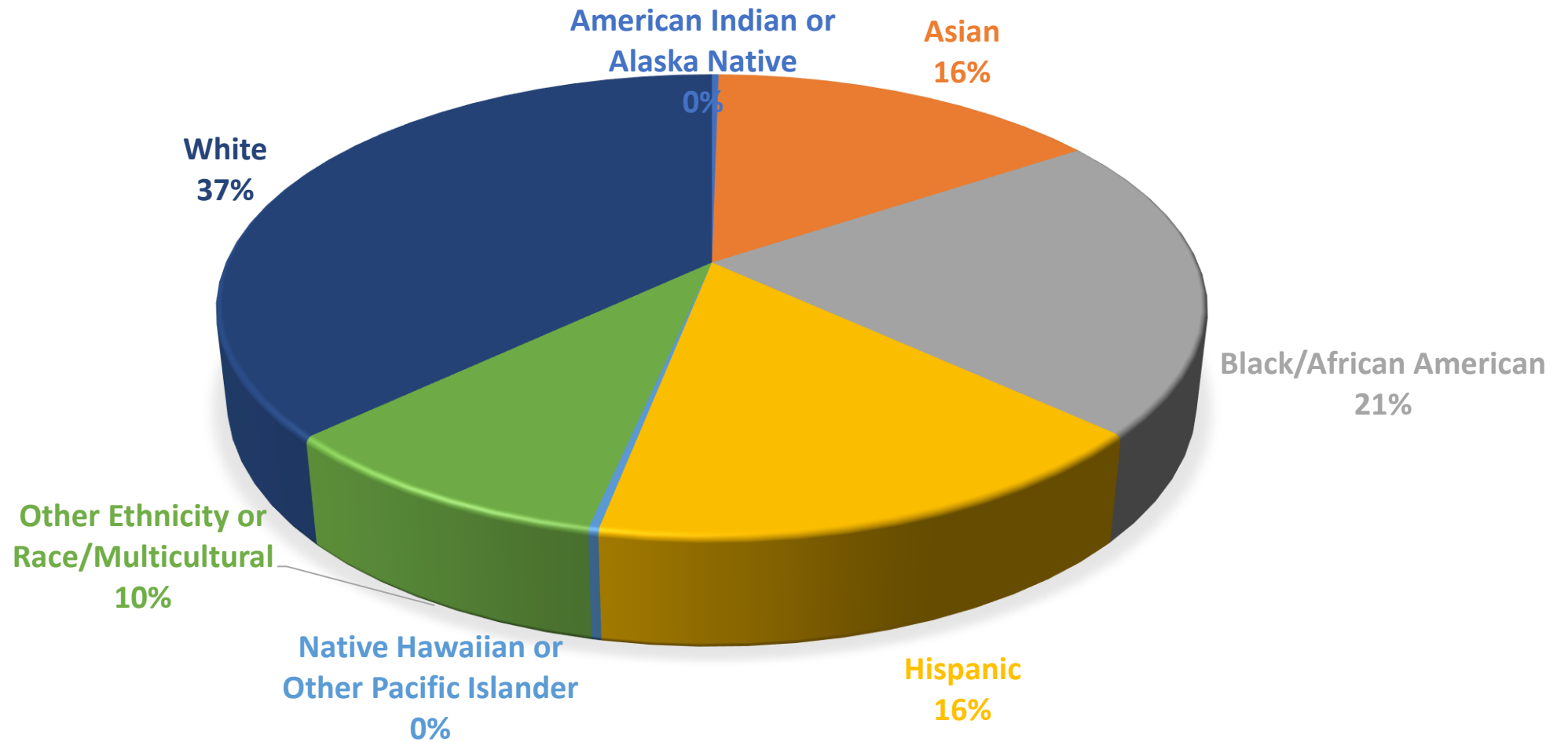

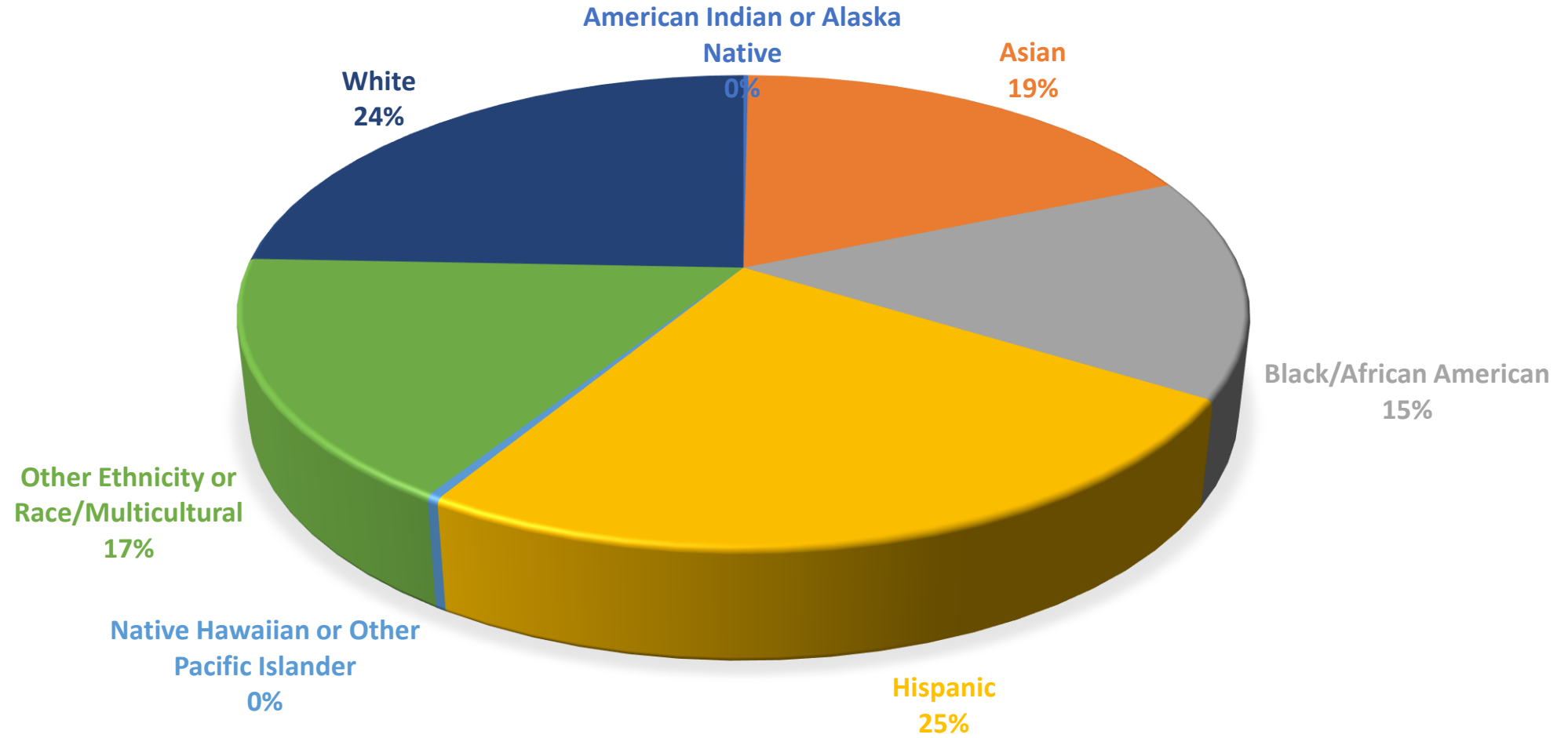
Consumers Ages 3 to 21

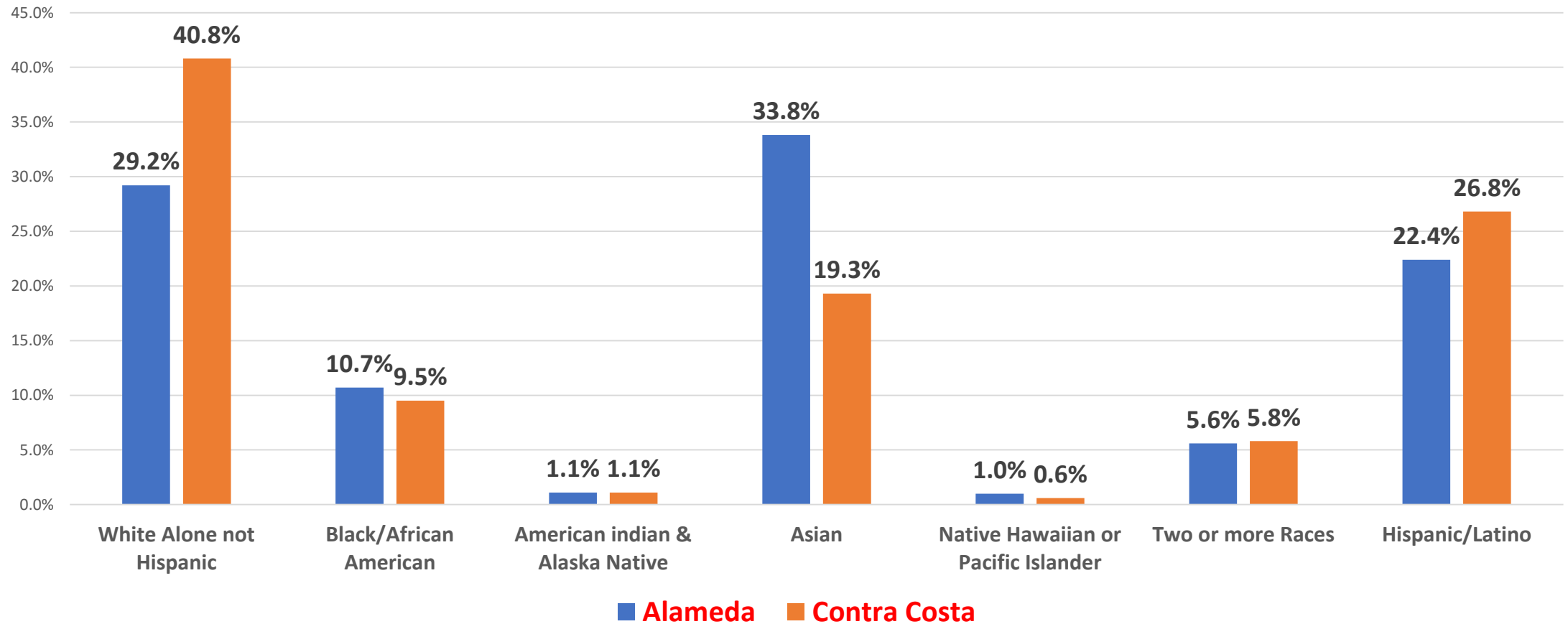

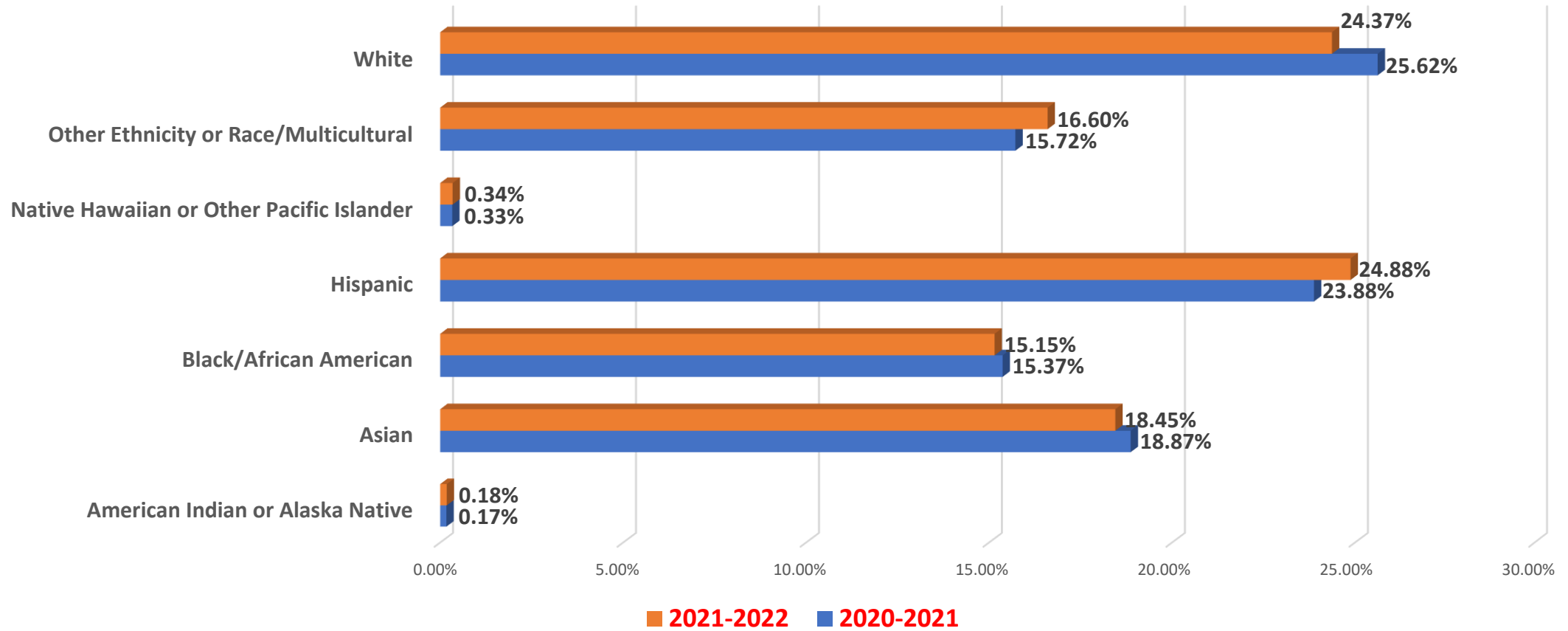

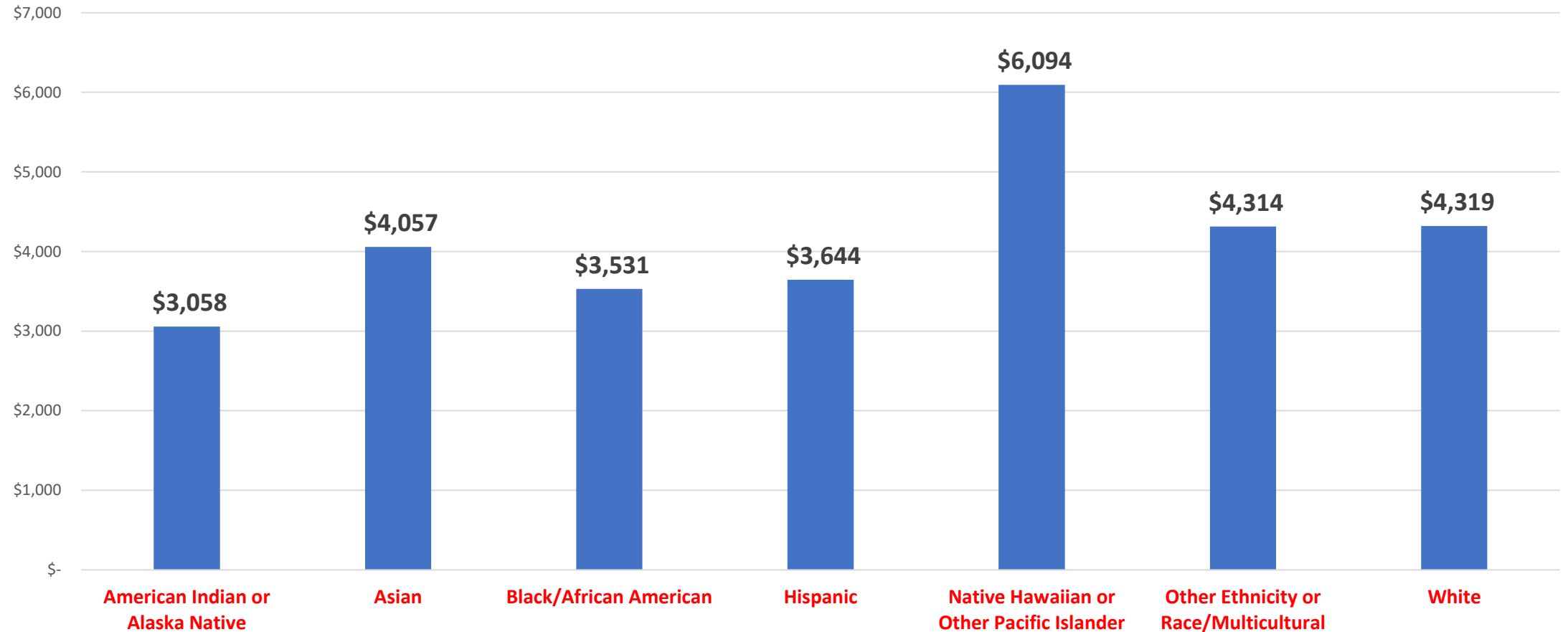

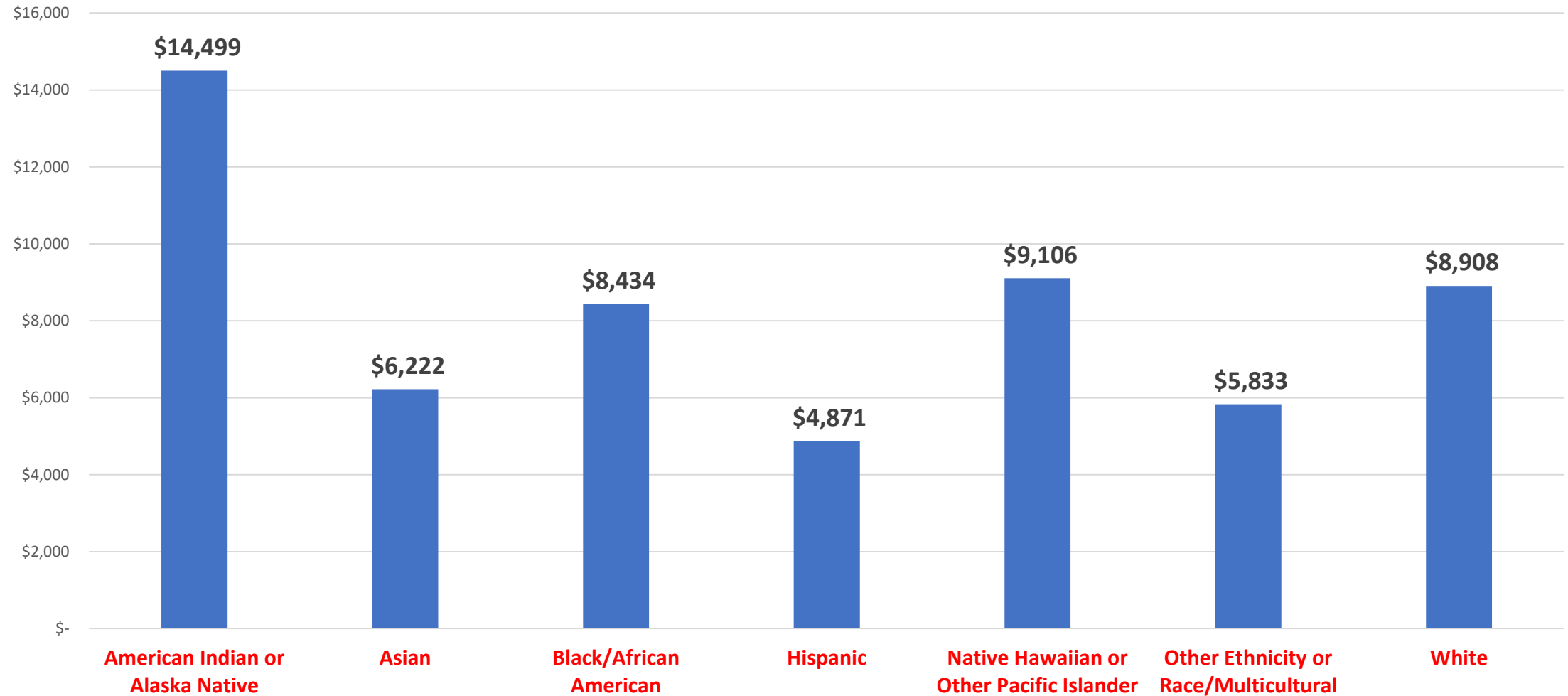

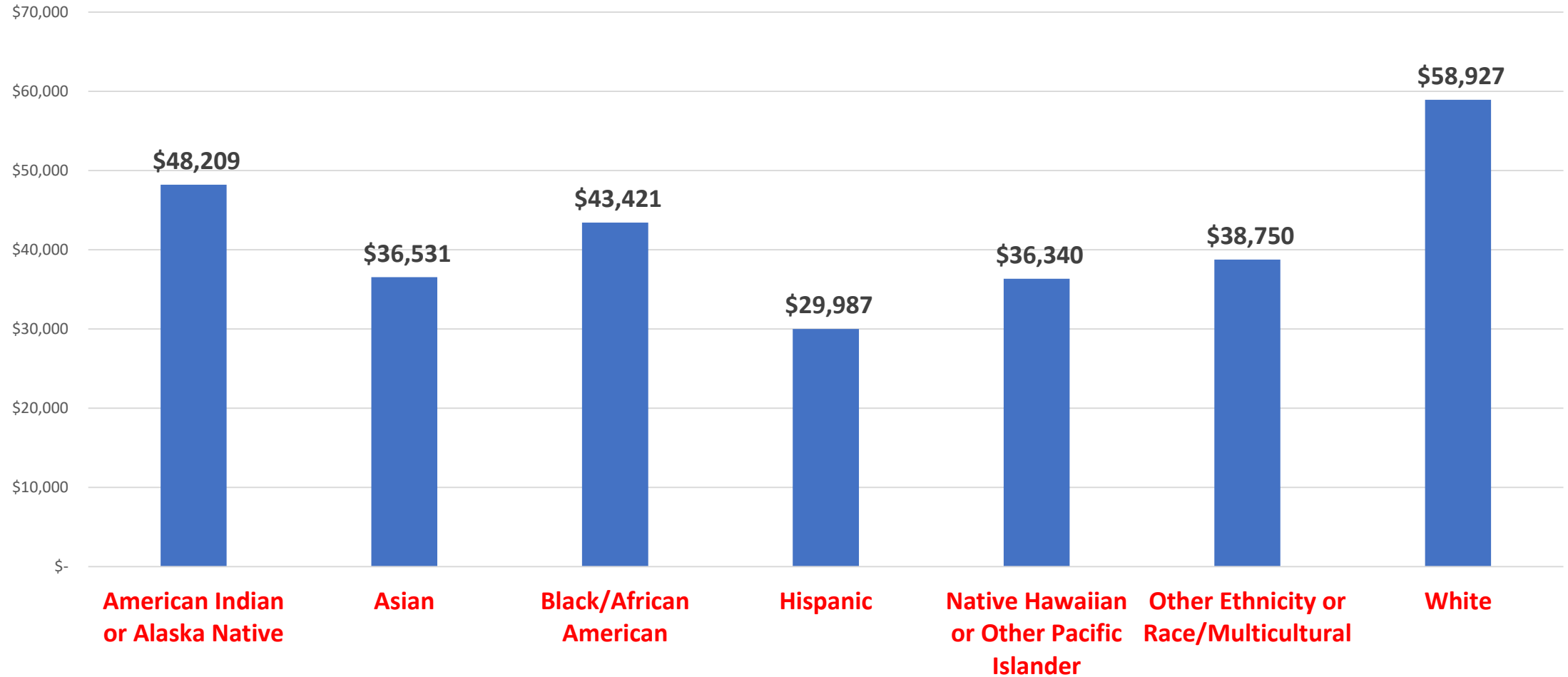
Expenditures: Ages 0 to 3



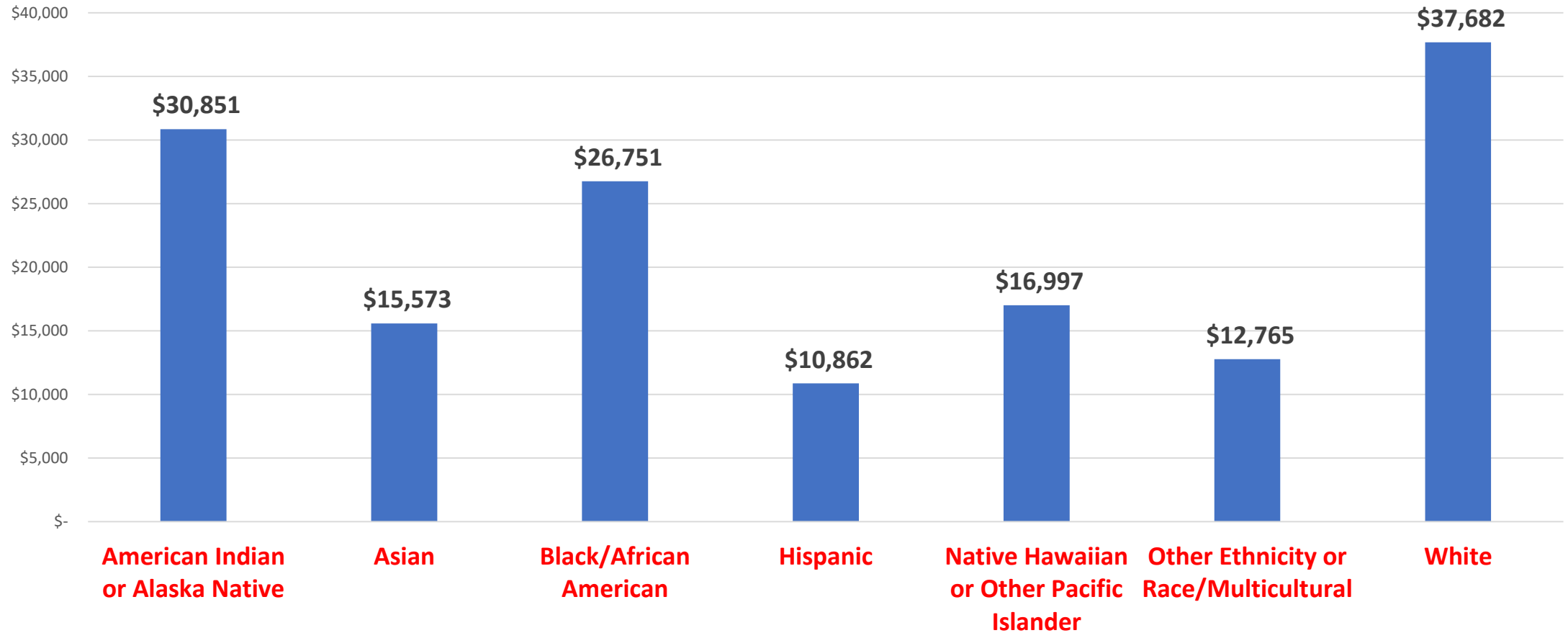
Expenditures: Ages 3 to 21



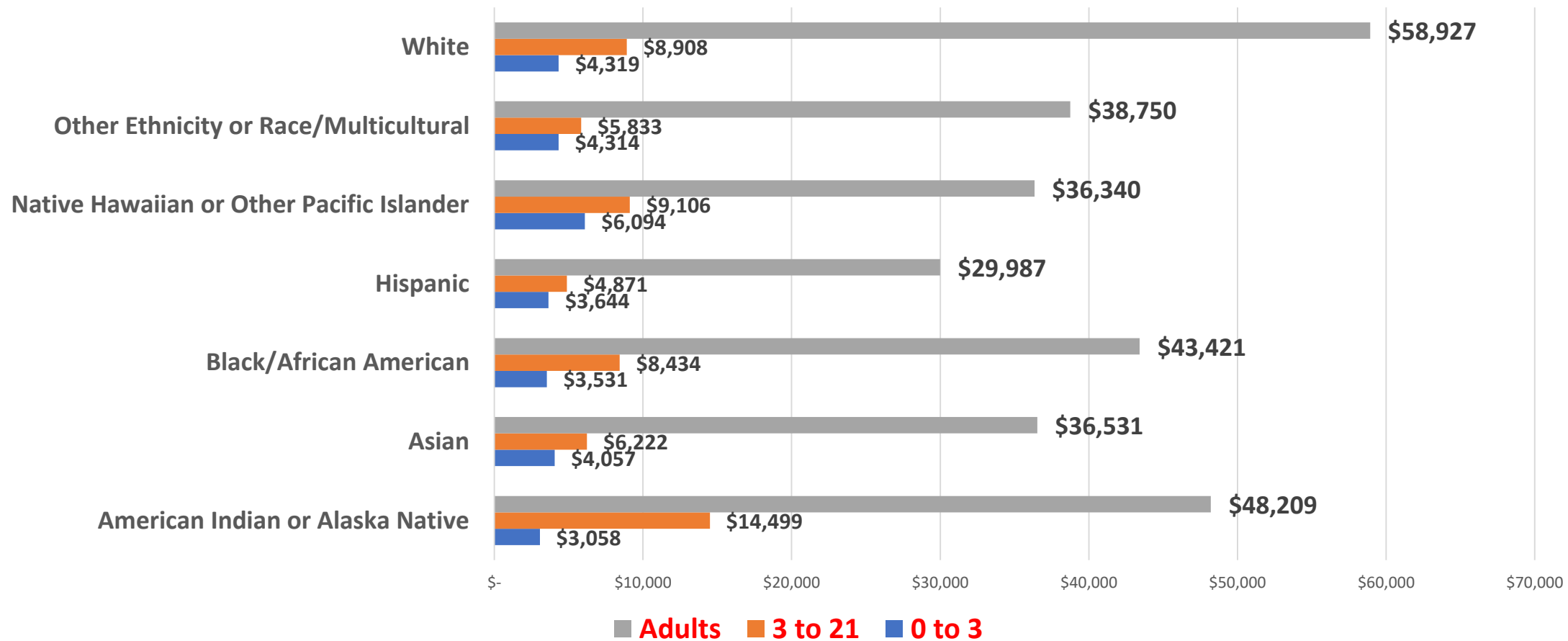
Expenditures: Ages 22 and Up



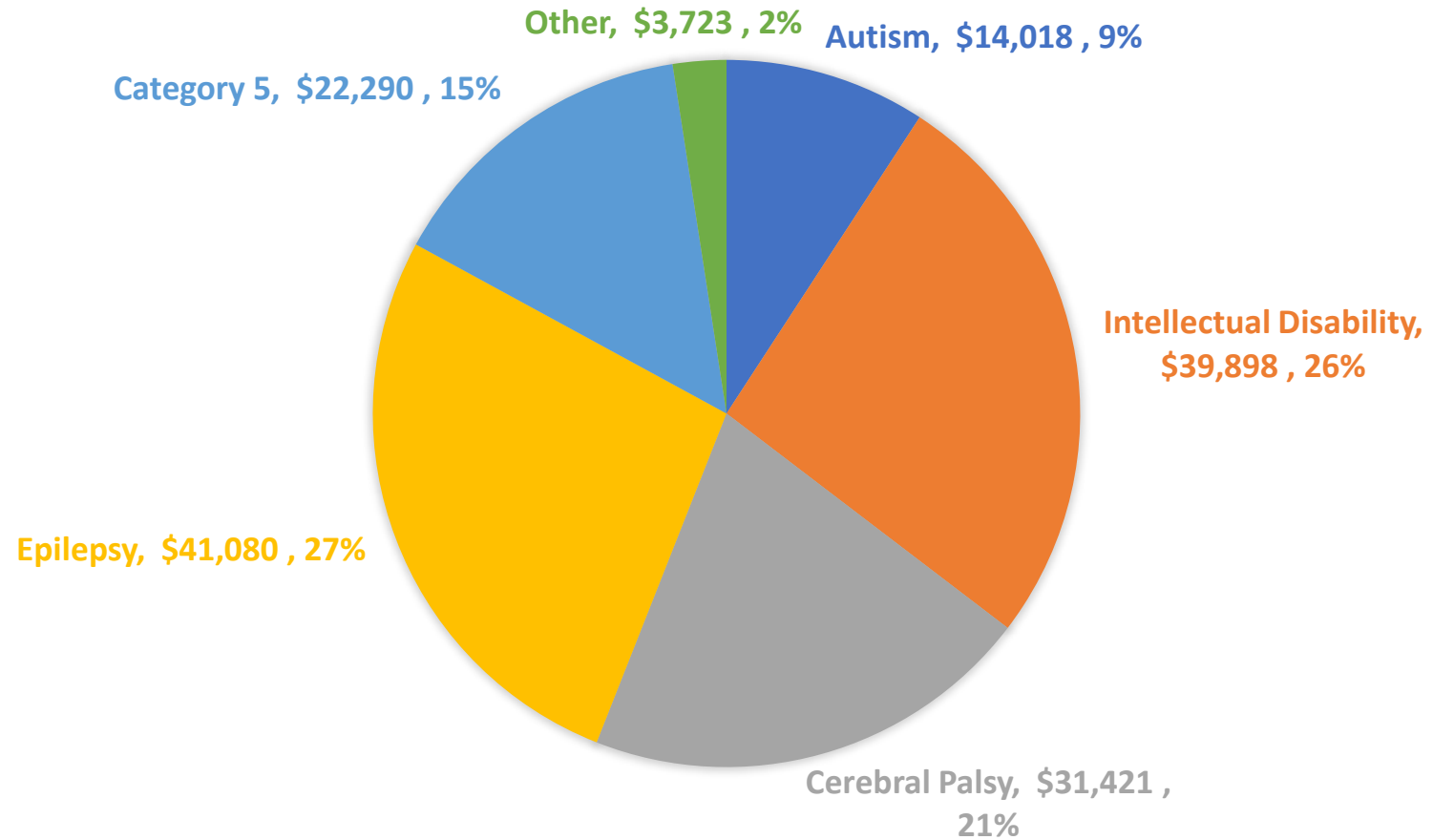
Expenditures: All Ages



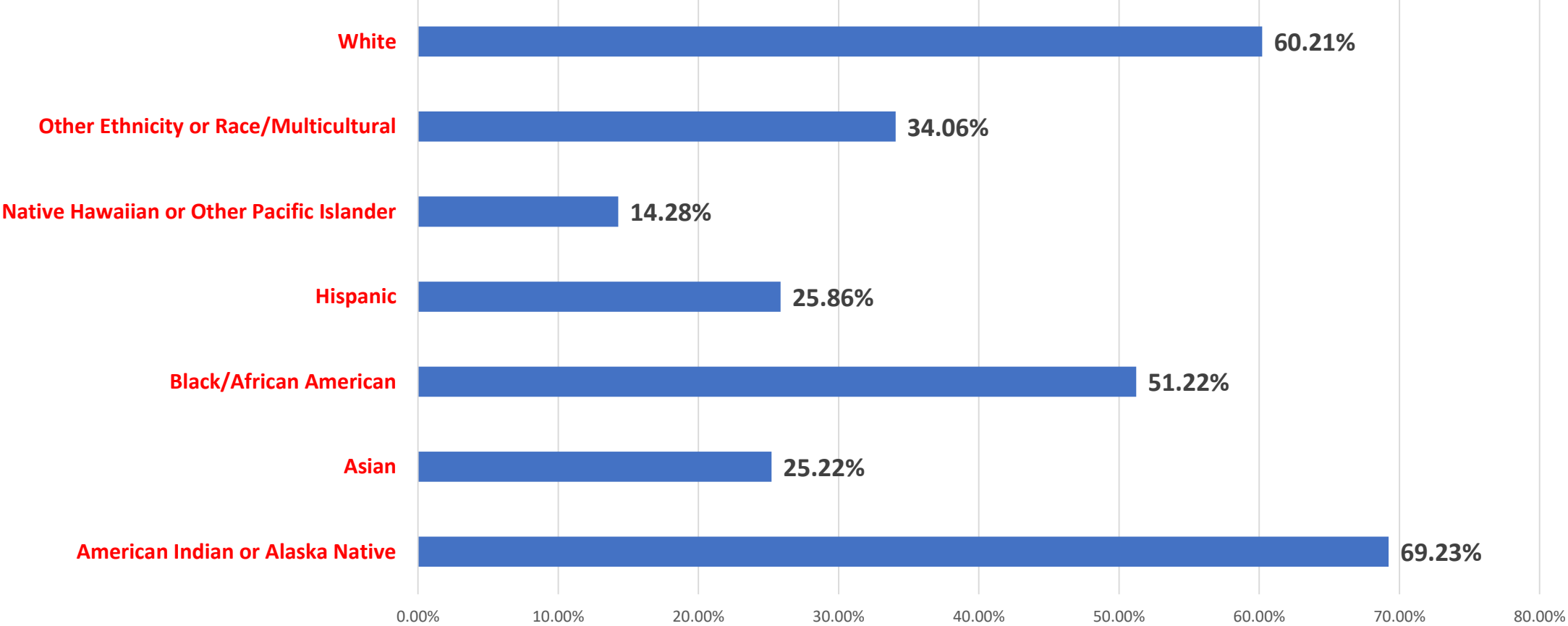
Expenditures by Age and Ethnicity/Race



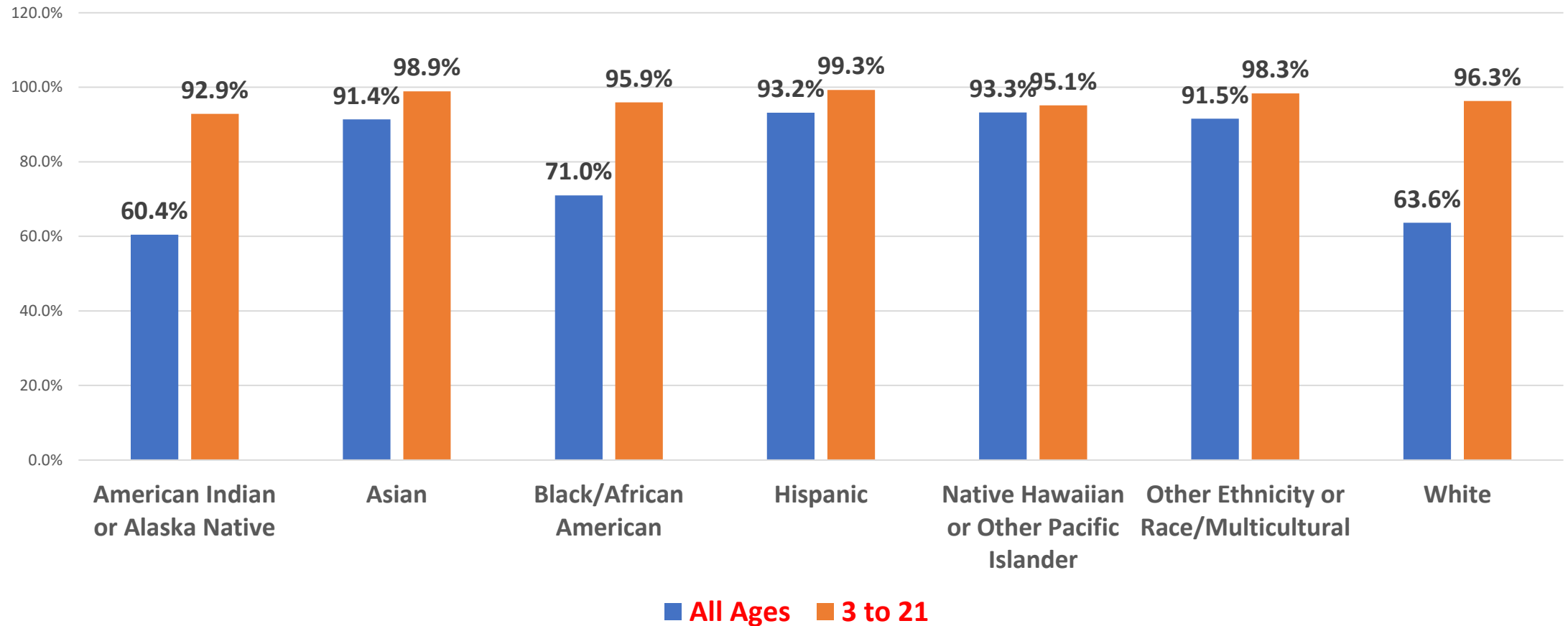
Expenditure by Diagnosis



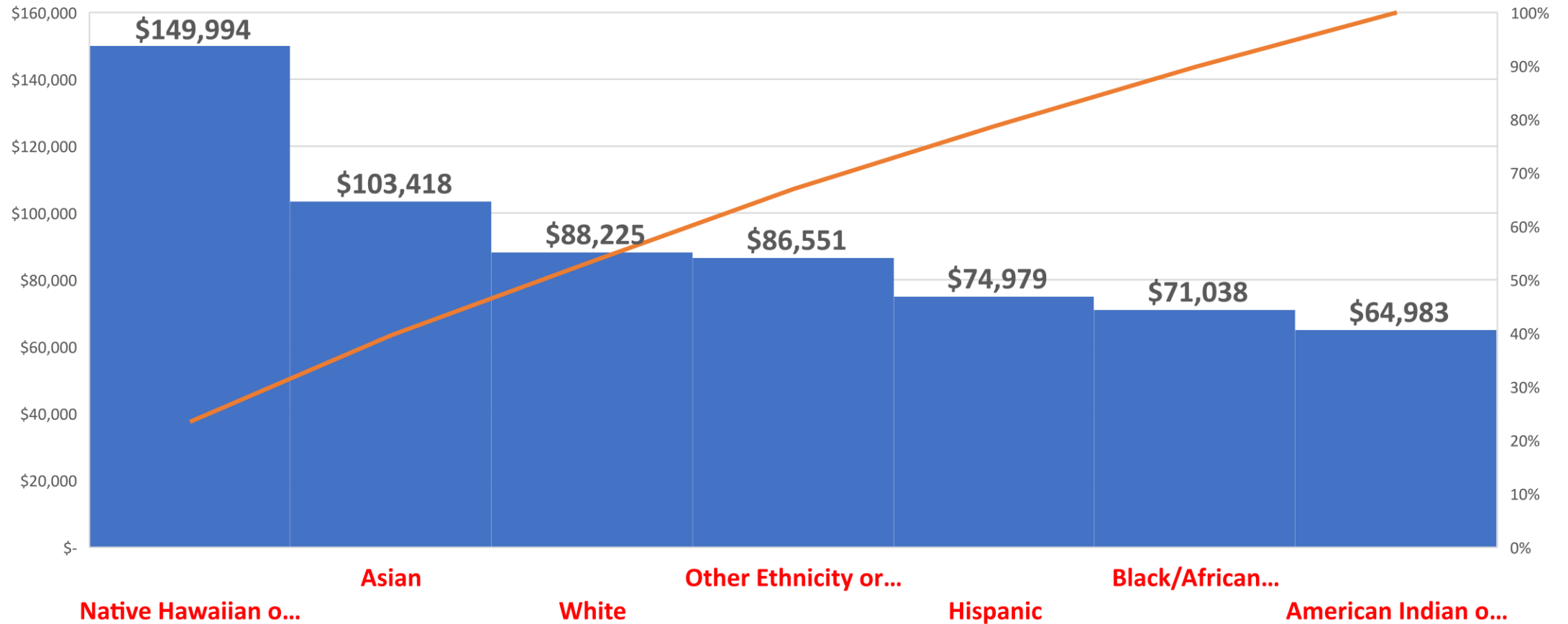
Adults living Out of Home by Ethnicity Race



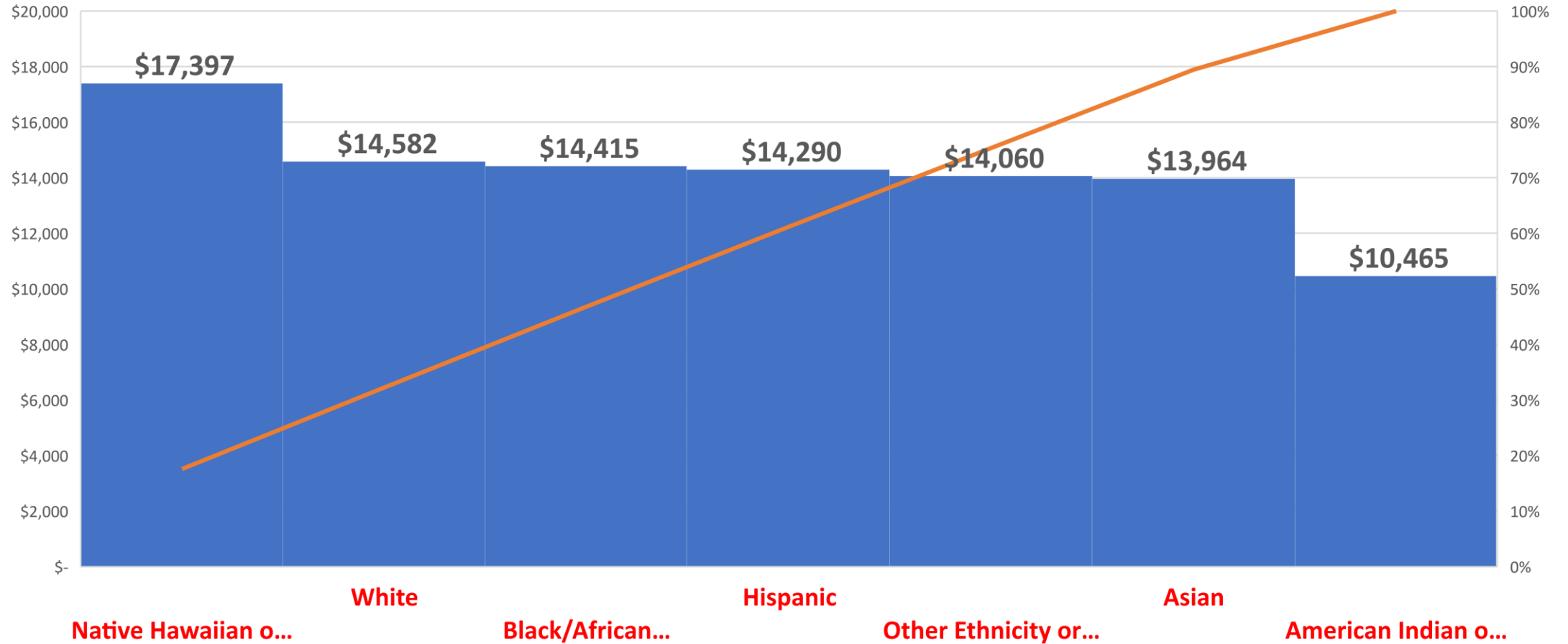
Living at Home: All Ages and 3 to 21



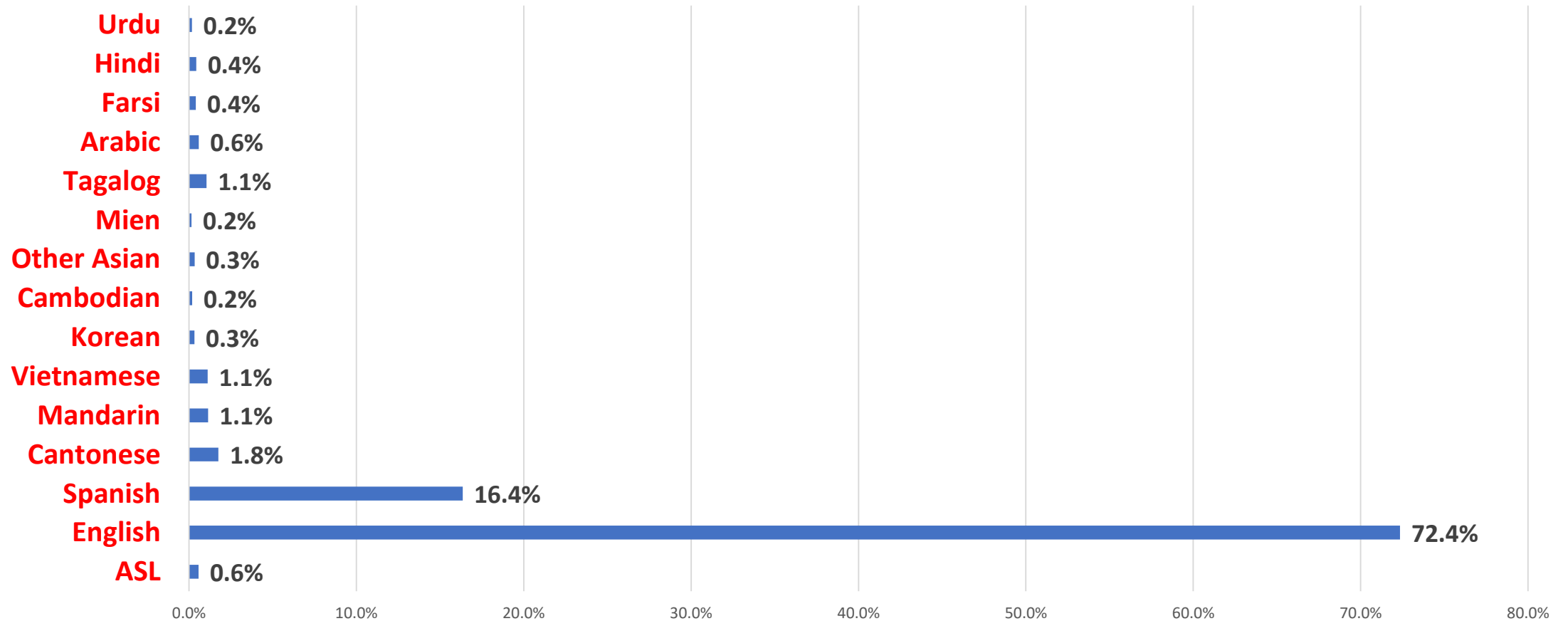
Expenditures for Adults Living Out of Home



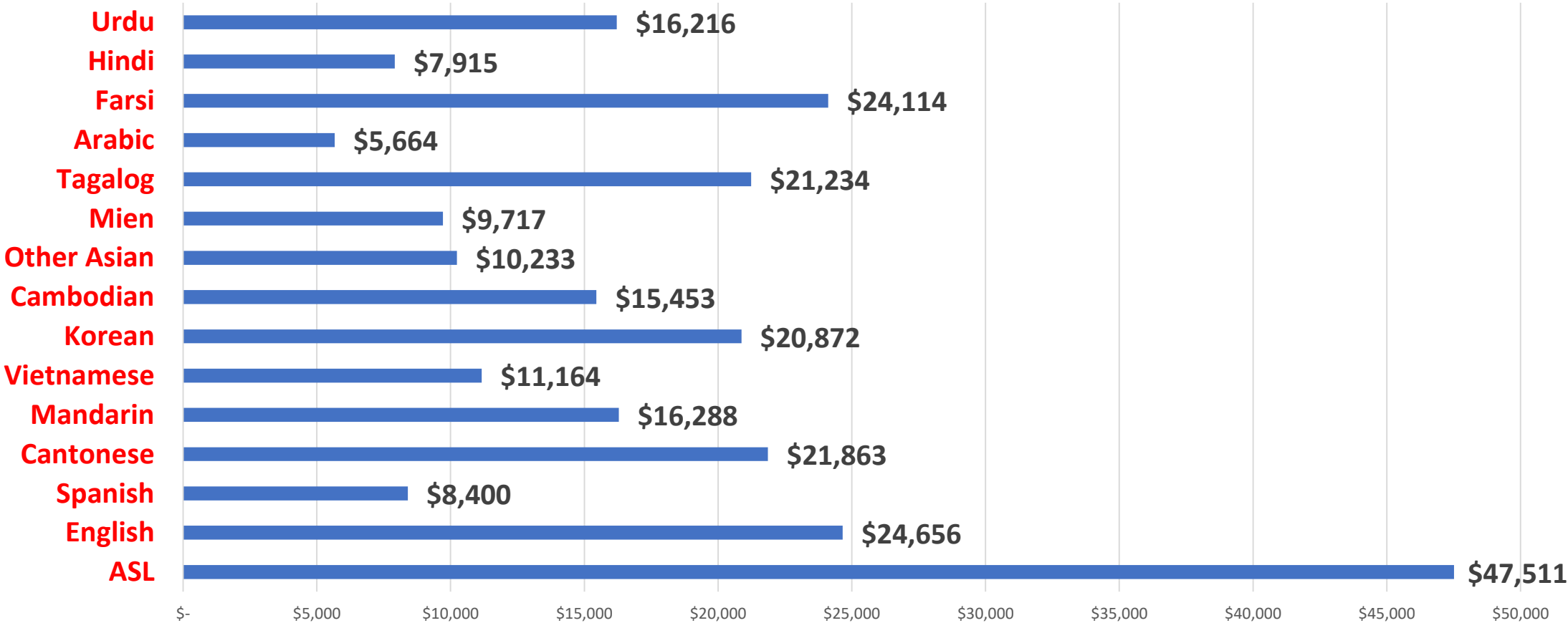

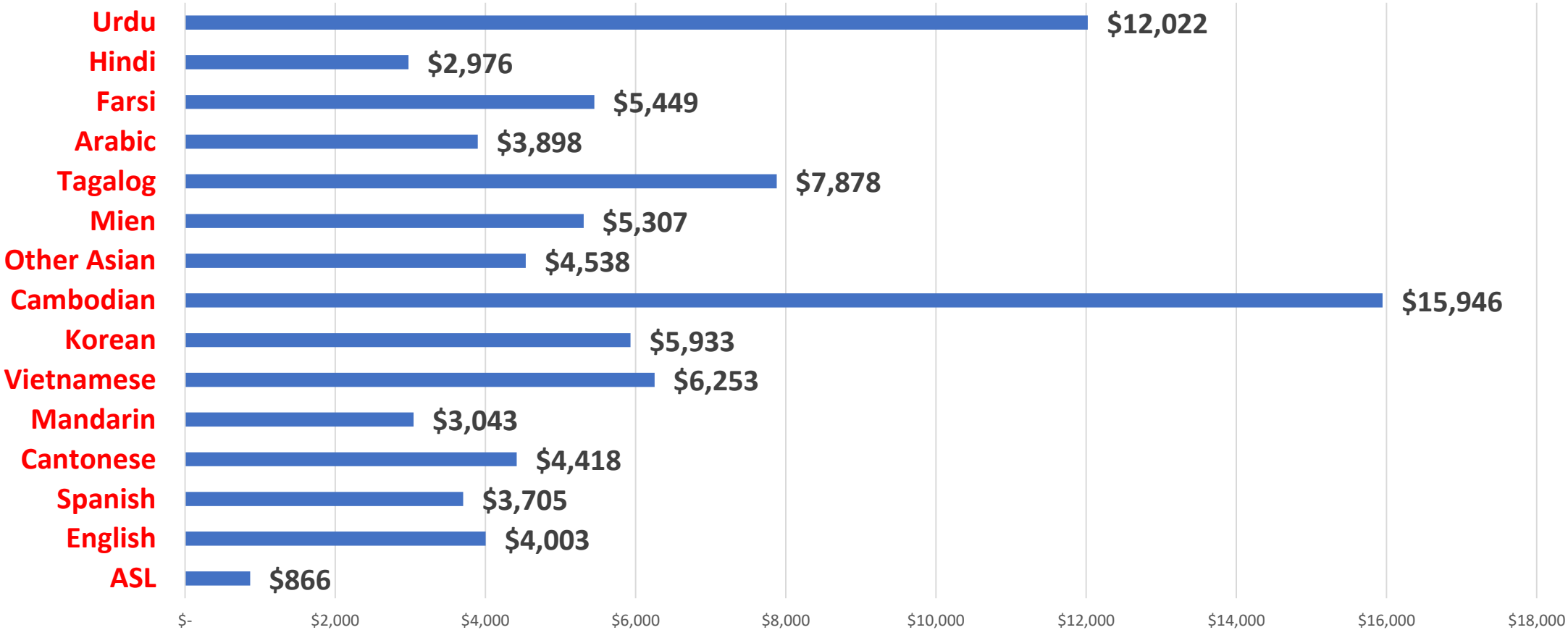

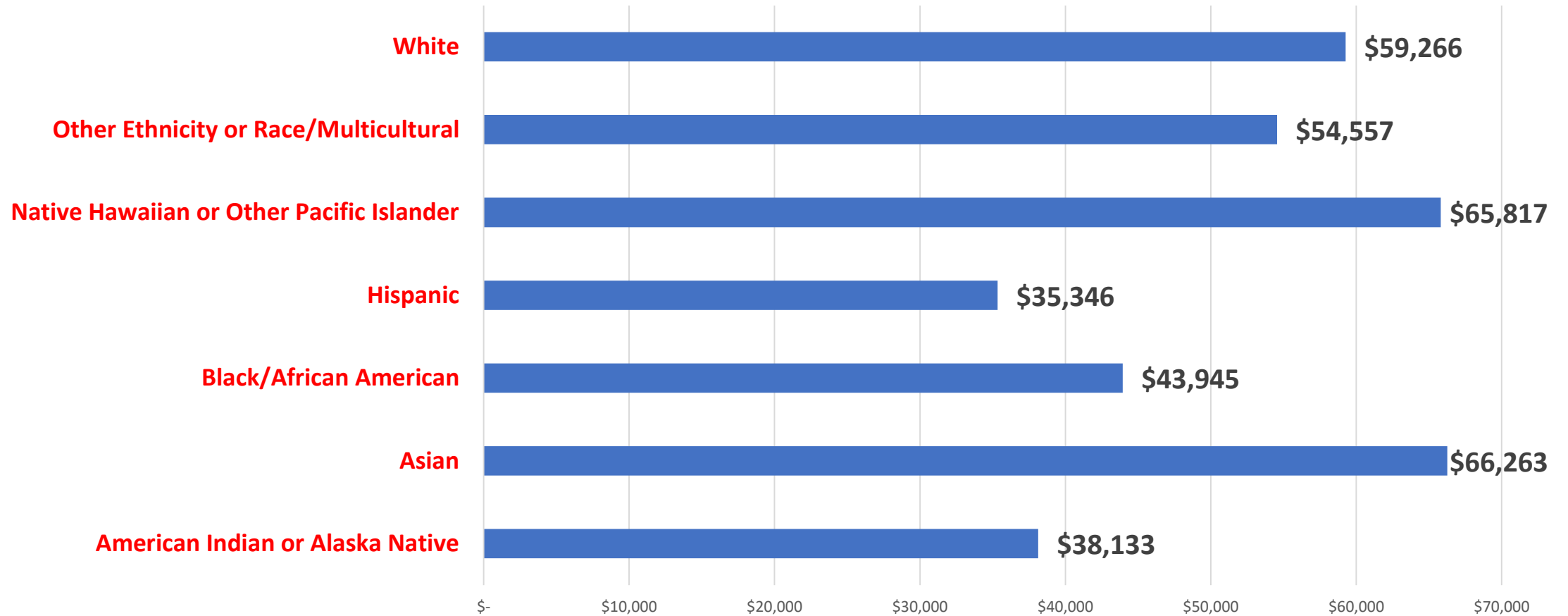
Expenditures by Language – All Ages



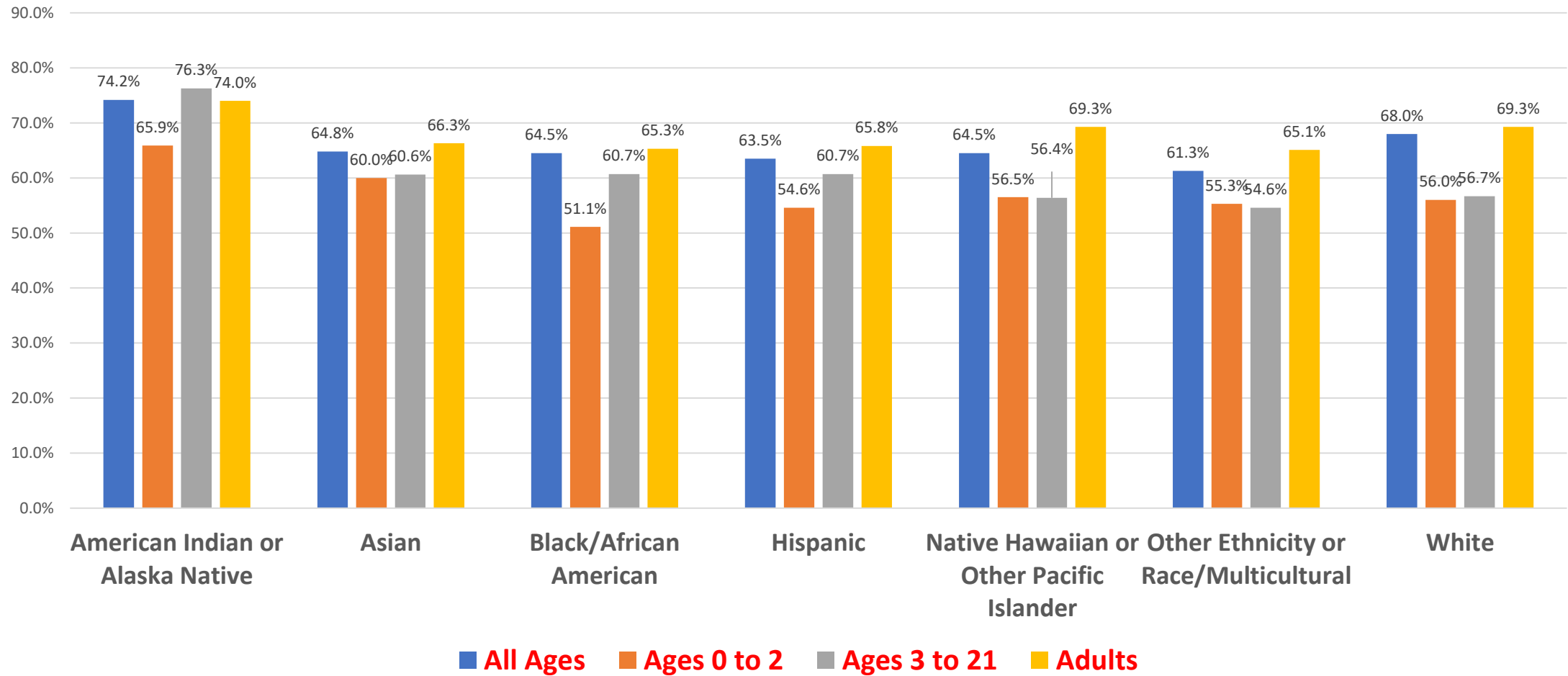
Expenditures by Language – Ages 0 to 3



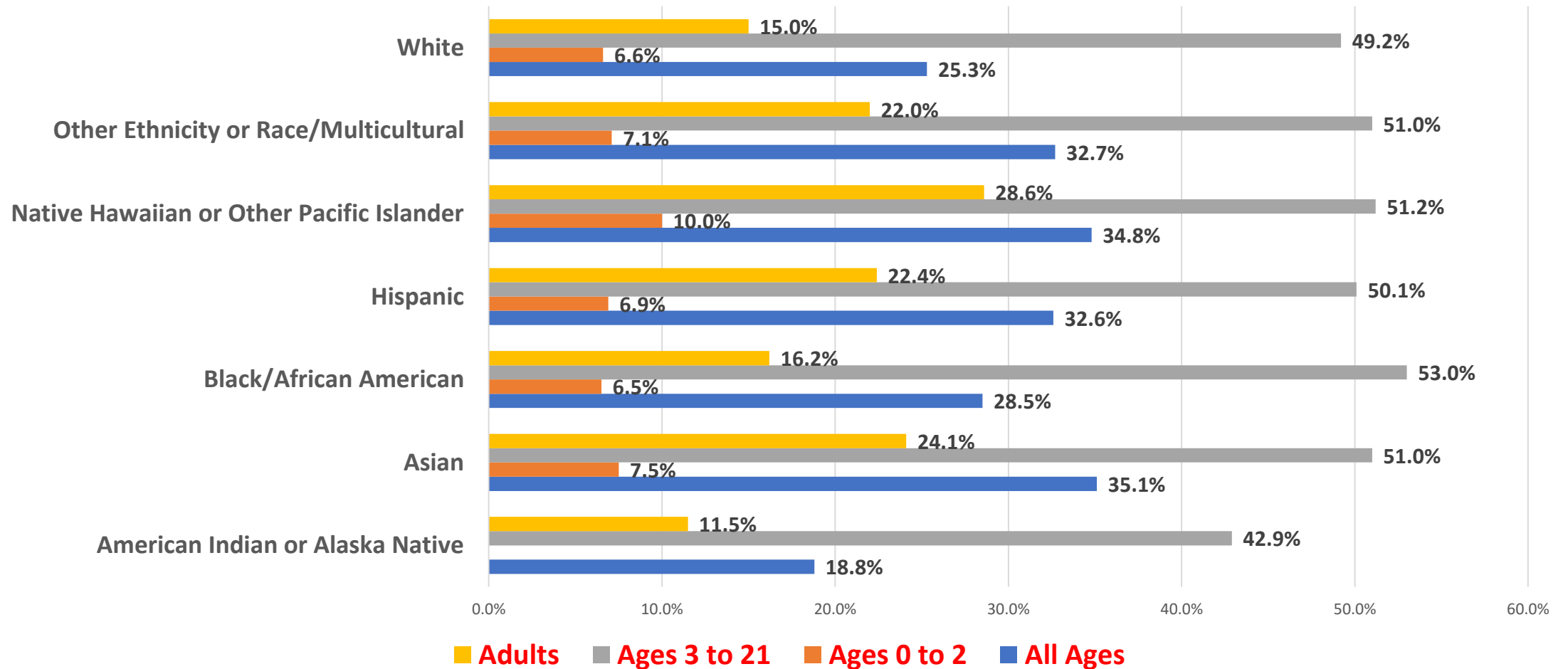
Expenditures for ILS/SLS Adults



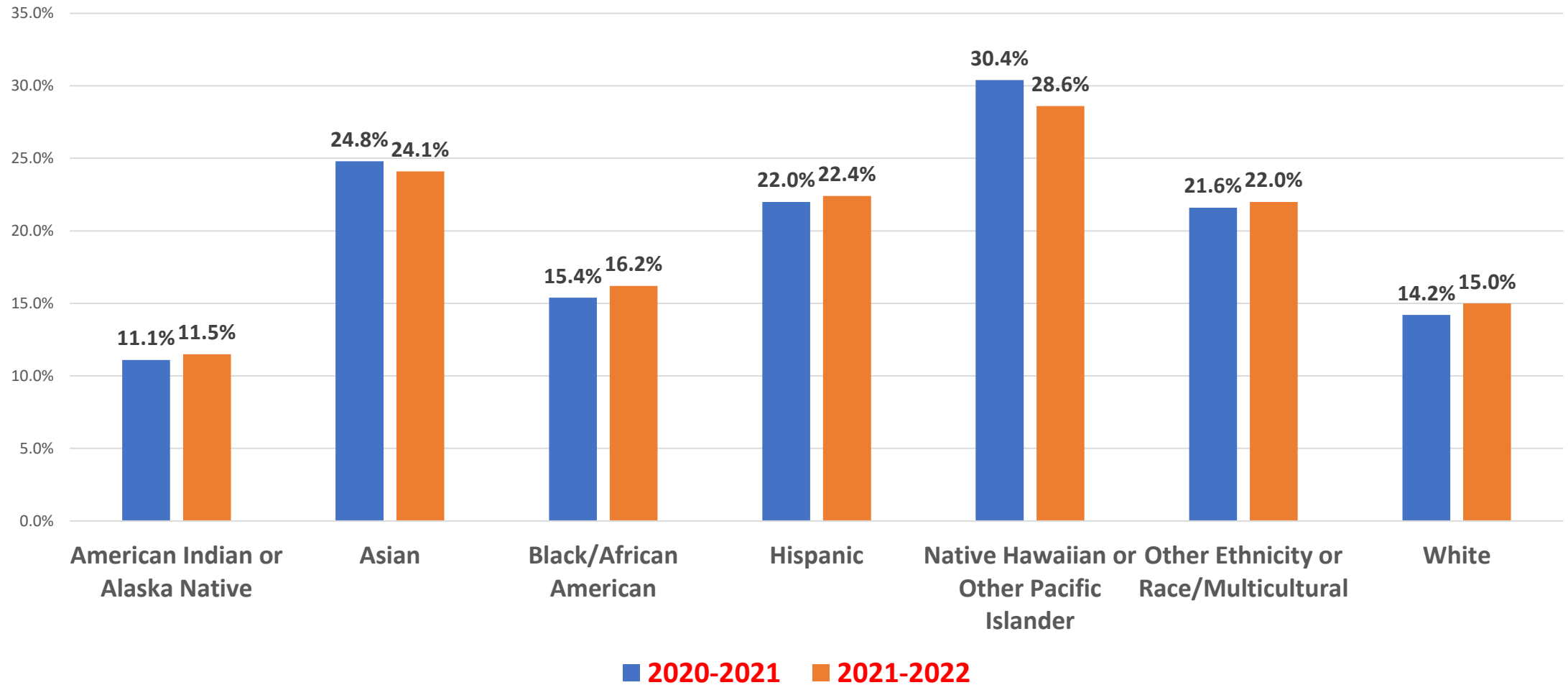
Utilization by Age



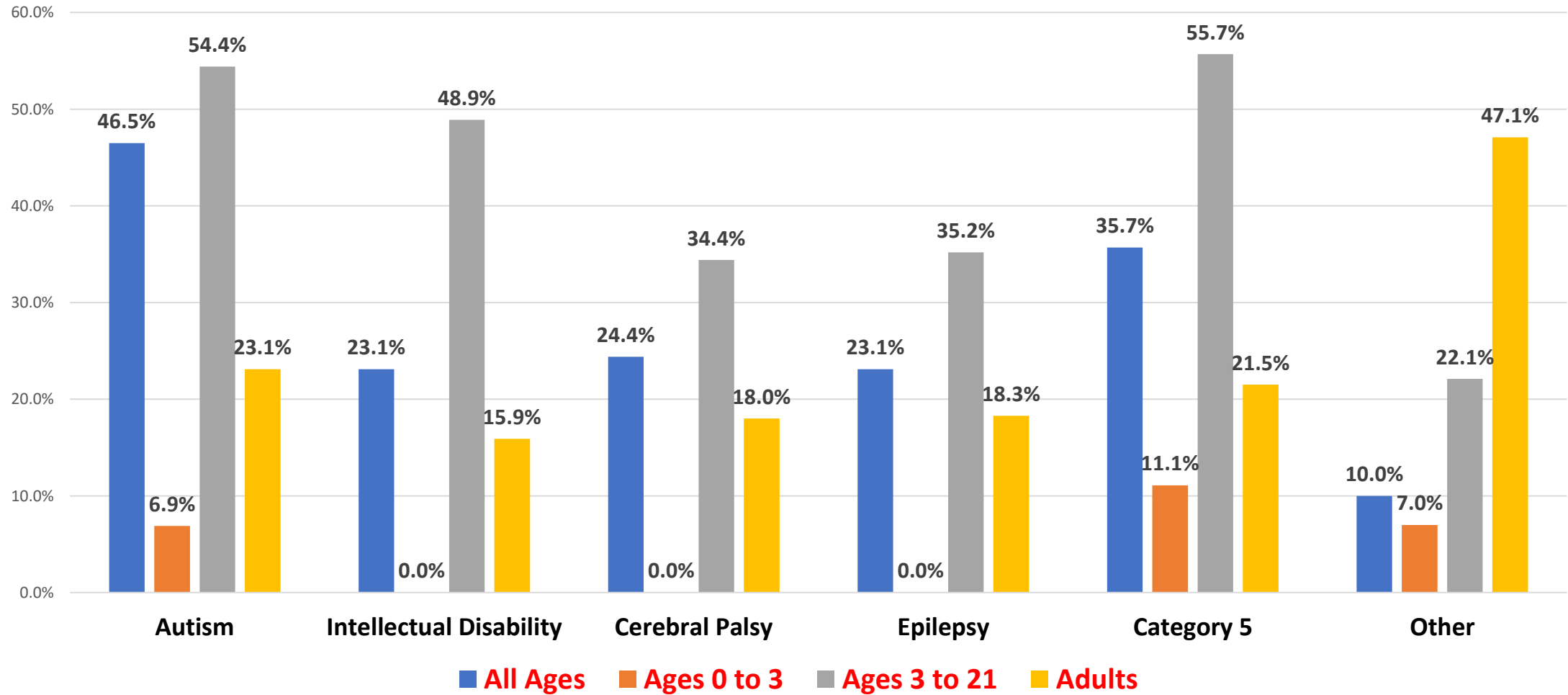
Consumers with NO POS – By Age



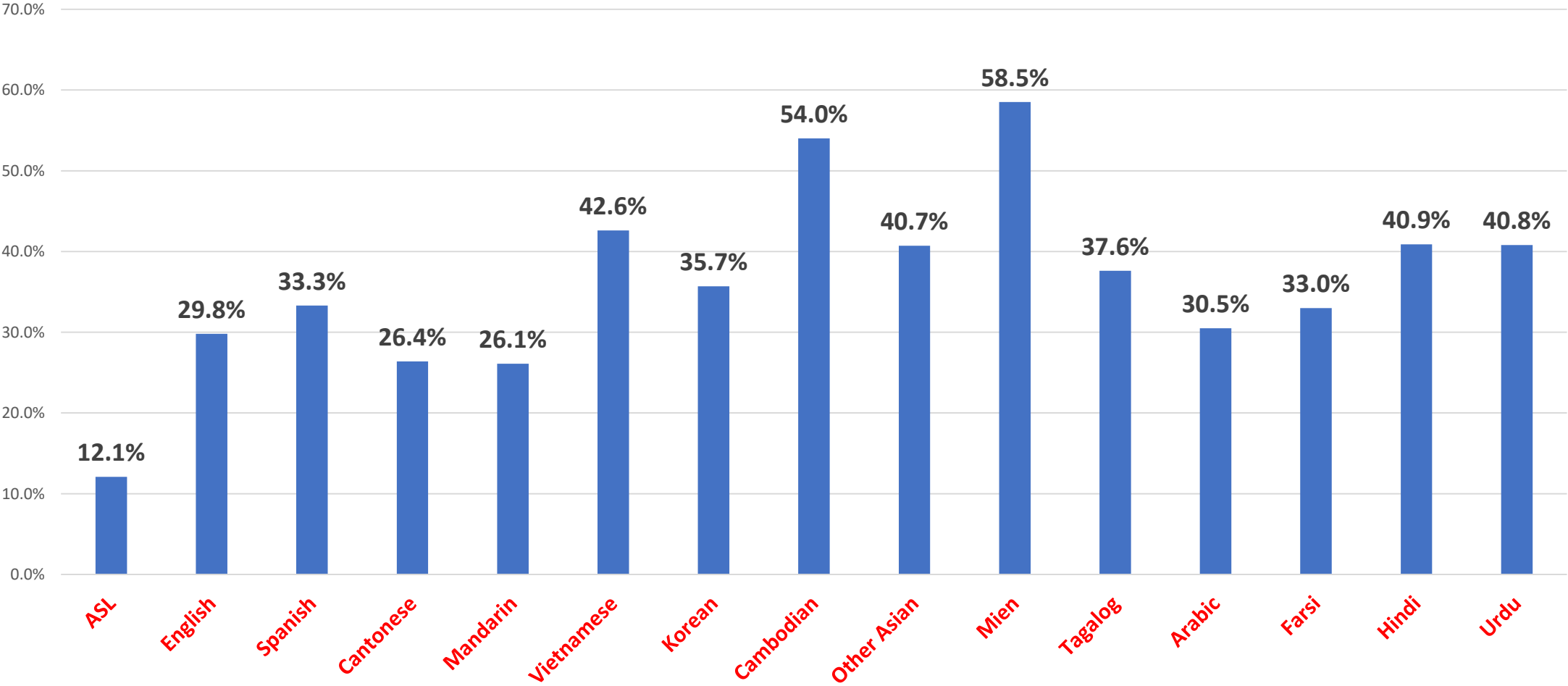
Adults with No POS – Year to Year



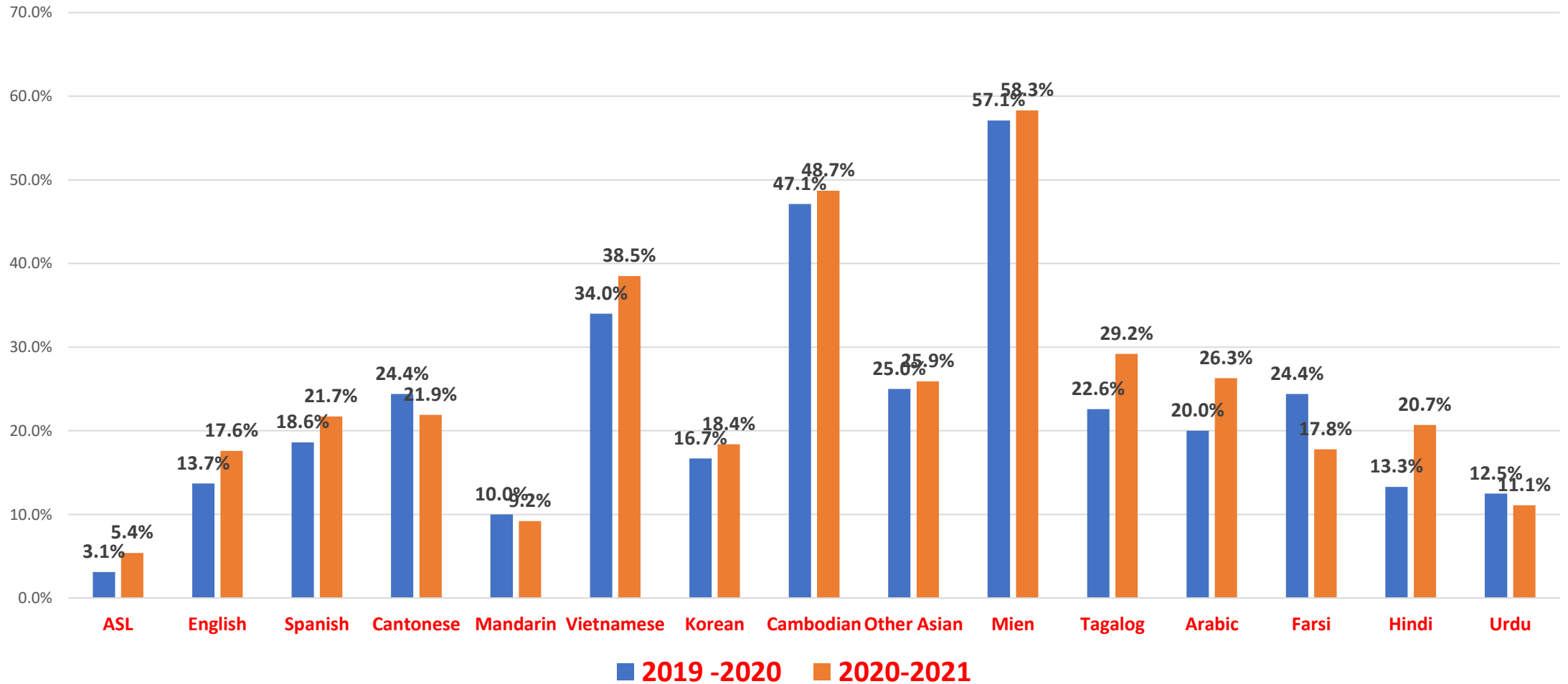
No POS by Diagnosis and Ages



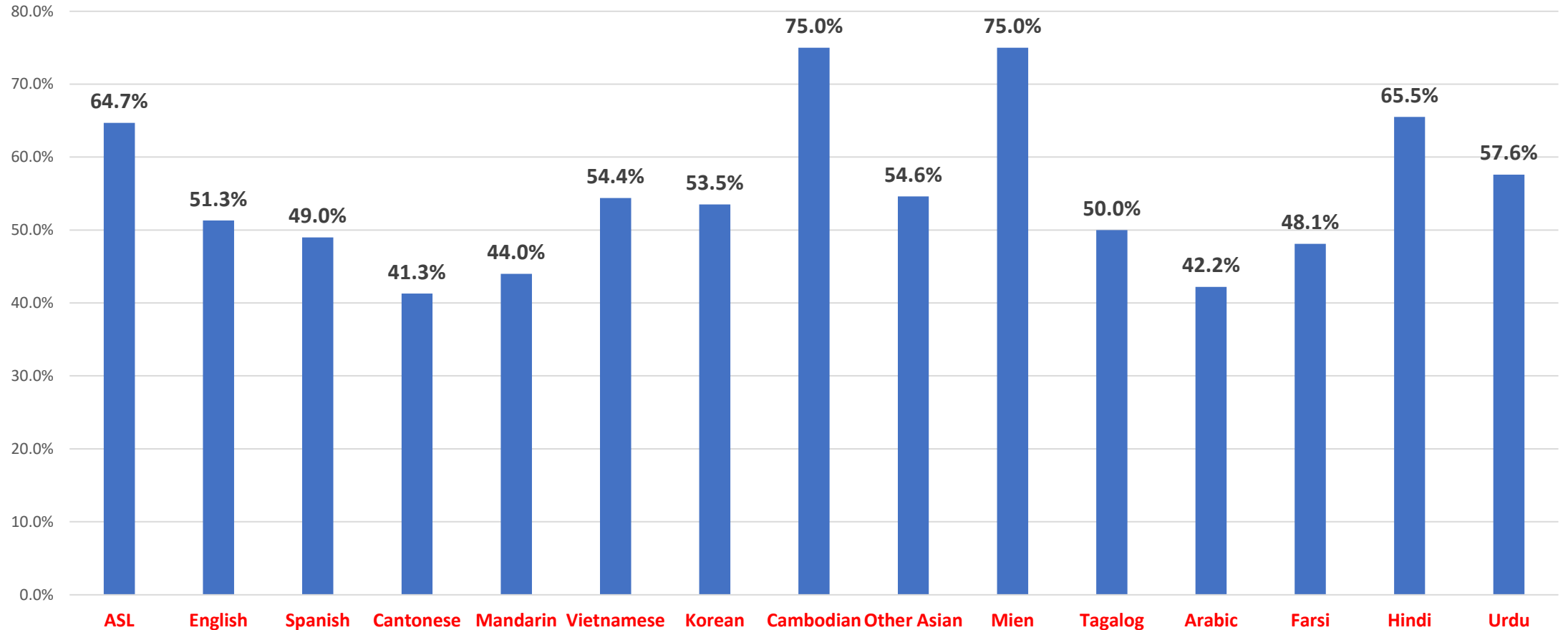
No POS by Language – All Ages



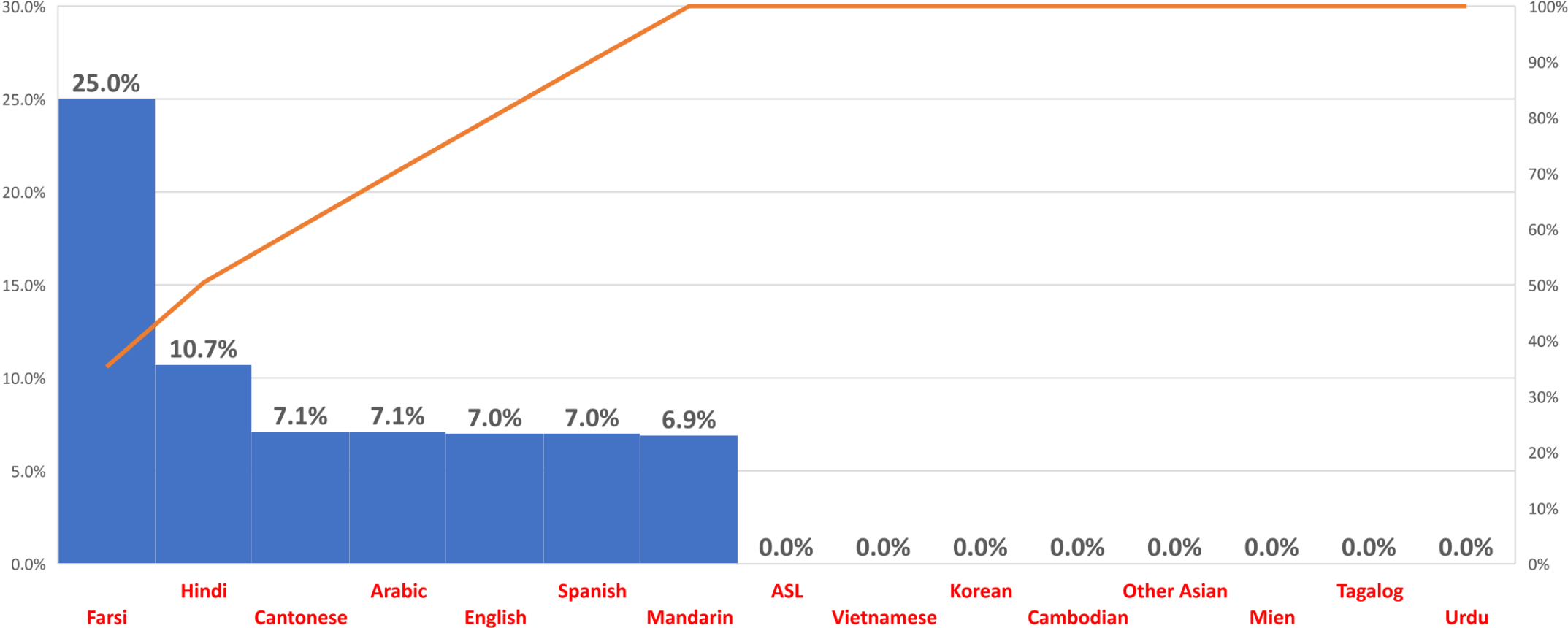
Adults with NO POS By Language Year to Year

Some Ongoing Efforts

- Multiple Community Based Organizations are implementing projects through the DDS' Service Access and Equity (SAE) Grant
- RCEB is receiving funds from DDS through the Language Access and Cultural Competency Grant (LCCC) to address language access and cultural resource needs, including translation/interpretation, staffing and other needs in collaboration with community partners
- Implicit Bias Training:
 - Focused on those involved in initial eligibility (assessors, psychologists, physicians) as well as other regional center staff

Some Ongoing Efforts

- Social Recreational Services , Camping, Non Medical Therapies now available to all RCEB consumers
- Community Navigator Programs:
 - At Family Resource Centers to provide help to families navigate the complex systems.
- Low to No POS Caseloads
 - 1 to 40 Ratio. Support and Education so Individuals and Families get needed services both from regional centers and other agencies. Stay on caseload for about one year
 - RCEB has 6 of these caseloads.

Some Ongoing Efforts

- The Self Determination Program, available to all Regional Center consumers. This program as well as Participant Directed Services provides more flexibility to access services in one's communities
- Coordinated Family Support Services- new program to support adults living in their family home to coordinate services and provide wrap around types of support based on assessment. Not here yet but coming very soon
